TILT's Signature Preserves and Trails are open to the public year-round, d<u>awn to dusk.</u>

CLAYTON, NY

Foster-Blake Woods Preserve

From the intersection of Rt. 12 and Rt. 12E in Clayton, head west on Rt. 12E toward Cape Vincent for 3.7 miles. The parking area is on the right (river side), opposite Pelo Rd.



Grindstone Island Preserves DOWNLOAD TRAIL GUIDE

There is no public transportation to Grindstone Island, but the preserves are open to the public. Potters Beach is at the western end of Grindstone, accessible from the water, and from North Shore Road. The Grindstone Island Nature Trail is at the eastern end of the Island and links Canoe Point State Park with Picnic Point State Park. It is accessible from the public docks at either park.

S. Gerald Ingerson Preserve & Sissy Danforth Rivergate Trail

East Line Road Access: Take State Rt. 12 south out of Clayton. From the stop light, travel onehalf mile to East Line Rd. Turn left onto East Line Rd. The trailhead is 1 mile ahead on your right, across from the Antique Boat Museum's Doebler Building.

Black Creek Road Access: Take State Rt. 12 south out of Clayton. From the stop light, travel 2.1 miles down East Line Rd, and turn right onto Black Creek Rd. Follow for 1.3 miles to the stone marker for the trail. The trail extends in a south-easterly direction from the road.

LaFargeville Access: Off State Route 411 (Theresa Street), opposite LaFargeville Agway

Address: 38973 Zenda Rd. From Clayton, take State Route 12E west toward Cape Vincent. Travel 1.3 miles from the stop light and turn right onto Zenda Rd. On the left is a parking area for the LoisJean and John MacFarlane Trail, which is across the road on the right.

ALEXANDRIA BAY, NY



Otter Creek Preserve DOWNLOAD TRAIL GUIDE

Address: 193 Church St. Within walking distance of the Village of Alexandria Bay, Otter Creek Preserve is on State Route 26. At the intersection of State Rt. 12 and State Rt. 26, turn south (away from the Village). The Preserve is four-tenths of a mile from the intersection, on the right.

HAMMOND, NY

Chippewa Bay Preserve

The Preserve is located at the end of New Road in Chippewa Bay. If you are using GPS to find it, look for Riverbay Adventure Inn at 97 New Rd. Once you reach Riverbay Adventure Inn, go straight ahead, up a slight rise into the woods. There is a small parking area about a guarter mile further ahead on the left.

Crooked Creek Preserve & the

Macsherry Trail DOWNLOAD TRAIL GUIDE

From Alexandria Bay, go north on Rt. 12 for 6.1 miles. Turn left toward Kring Point State Park, then turn immediately right onto Indian Point Rd. (a dirt road). This road is marked private, but visitors are welcome. Travel approximately 3/4 mile to the parking area on the right.
